information project CNKI (China)**



China National Knowledge Infrastructure, CNKI is a global information project of the People's Republic of China (PRC), Tsinghua University (Beijing), and Tsinghua Tongfang Holdings, launched back in 1996. Tsinghua University (founded in 1911) – one of China's leading universities. Chinese President Xi Jinping graduated from this university.

At present, CNKI (China National Knowledge Infrastructure) is the largest academic database in China. CNKI resources are widely used by universities, research institutes, government agencies, analysis centers, companies, hospitals and public libraries around the world.

According to the official CNKI portal, currently more than 1,500 universities, research institutes, government organizations, companies and enterprises in 53 countries, including Russia, and more than 25,000 organizations in China itself are CNKI users.

The issues of the journal «Nanotechnology in construction» are planned to be published in CNKI database starting from № 1, 2020.
