To provide maximal availability to materials all issues are published at the edition's website <http://Nanobuild.ru>; the papers (metadata) is added to citation systems (data bases): DOAJ (Sweden), EBSCO Publishing (USA), Scientific Electronic Library (Russia), ProQuest (USA); ResearchBib (Japan) et al. That allows scientists and specialists around the world to have free access to materials of the journal and to use them in research activity, to make references to them.
